## **Pemakluman Lengkap**

### **a) Pemakluman Berkenaan Pendaftaran Pengamal Perubatan Tradisional dan Komplementari (PT&K) Tempatan**

- i. Pendaftaran hanya akan dilaksanakan bagi bidang amalan yang diiktiraf iaitu:
  - a) Perubatan Tradisional Melayu
  - b) Perubatan Tradisional Cina
  - c) Perubatan Tradisional India
  - d) Homeopati
  - e) Osteopati
  - f) Kiropraktik
  - g) Pengubatan Islam
- ii. Pendaftaran pengamal PT&K tempatan akan dilakukan secara berperingkat mengikut zon dan ketetapan seperti berikut:

**b) Pemakluman Berkenaan Pendaftaran Pengamal Perubatan Tradisional dan Komplementari (PT&K) Warga Asing**

Pendaftaran bagi pengamal PT&K warga asing akan dibuka kepada pihak pemohon dari seluruh negara tanpa pembahagian mengikut zon. Pihak pemohon dibenarkan untuk membuat permohonan 5 bulan sebelum tarikh akhir pas pengajian yang terkini.

#### **a) Information on Registration of Local Traditional & Complementary Medicine (T&CM) Practitioners**

i. Registration will only be open for the following recognised practice areas.

- a) Traditional Malay Medicine
- b) Traditional Chinese Medicine
- c) Traditional Indian Medicine
- d) Homeopathy
- e) Osteopathy
- f) Chiropractic
- g) Islamic Medical Practice

ii. Registration for local T&CM practitioners will be conducted in phases and zones as follows:

4.	Eastern	Kelantan, Terengganu dan Pahang	15 December 2021- 14 March 2022
5.	Sabah & Sarawak	Sabah, Sarawak dan WP Labuan	15 March 2022- 14 June 2022
